

Fundraising Made Easy with Scrip

Attention Squalicum Families! You can purchase scrip cards yourself or have your student sell scrip cards to friends and family. Scrip is a fantastic fundraising program because cards are purchased and redeemed at face value--there are no additional costs! Scrip cards can be used same as cash at the different participating businesses.

Squalicum High School PTSA is currently able to purchase scrip from Haggen, Woods Coffee and through Great Lakes Fundraising (a larger fundraising company with more options). Students will receive a percentage (dividend) into their ASB accounts as follows:

- Haggen and Woods Coffee pay 10% of card amount (with 9% to student's ASB account and *1% to SQHS PTSA)
- Great Lakes retailers pay varying percentages as indicated on www.shopwithscrip.com. *Note that students will directly receive 1% less than what it says on website with that *1% going to SQHS PTSA)

**1% goes to SQHS PTSA to help pay for mini-grants.*

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE DIRECTIONS TO ORDER SCRIP!

1. Submit your order on-line

For Haggen and Woods: use the **On-Line Squalicum Scrip Order Form** from the PTSA page on the school website. *(Please try to use the on-line order form. This saves the parent volunteers who work on Scrip a lot of time. If it is not possible, there is a printable form you can complete by hand and send in the envelope with your payment).*

For script through Great Lakes Fundraising, use the Great Lakes ordering process (link from the PTSA page on school website)

- 2. Put payment for amount of cards ordered (checks to SQHS PTSA) in an envelope marked "Scrip" and have your student put it in the PTSA payment box outside of the ASB office by 2:30 of the deadline date for the month.** Pre-payment is required. Only orders paid in advance by the deadline will be processed for the month.

December and June are good times to stock up on scrip.
Note the early deadlines for these months.

- 3. Pick up your cards on the Wednesday following the Scrip due date** from Shawn Flaherty in the ASB Office OR you can authorize your student to pick them up on the order form.
