When do I get my cap and gown? Cap and gowns will be given out on **Monday April 30th** during both lunches, or in the ASB office for those unable to attend that day.

How do I request my final transcript to be sent to my college next year? A form will be available on the school website and in the Counseling office, fill out the form and leave it with Mrs. Faria this will be the same form used for college and scholarship information for the Graduation Program

How do I get my college and scholarship information included in the Graduation Program? Fill out the Transcript request & College Scholarship form, available on the website and in the Counseling office. Leave with Mrs. O'Brien and Mrs. Faria before **May 25, 2018**

What is Senior Clearance? Your final check out from Squally, ALL students need to check with the Library, and ASB office to pay any fines, you will check out with your current teachers, Running Start students check out with Mrs. O'Brien, ALL students complete a final Survey located on ONENOTE on Before you turn in your computer on **JUNE 4th** Mrs. O'Brien.

When do we Get tickets for graduation. Tickets will be given to students *after Senior Clearance forms are turned in June 4-7* to the ASB office with Ms. Flaherty, ASB Bookkeeper

Who gets an honor designation (honor cord, etc.) at Graduation?

Students with a 3.5 cumulative GPA at the end of Fall Semester of their Senior Year (7th semester of high school) earn this Honor Designation and are entitled to wear an Honor Cord. Your Spring Semester grades from this year are NOT included in this calculation.
