## Whatcom Community College Course and Credit Equivalency Guide for 2021-2022

This document is meant only as a reference guide. If you intend to earn a Bellingham Public School Diploma using community college courses to earn credit, please work with your school counselor and Running Start Advisor to ensure each course you take and credit you complete contributes to, and satisfies, Bellingham Public Schools graduation requirements.

Please know that any course number below 100 level are not considered 'college level' and are not funded by the Running Start program. Please check with your Whatcom Community College counselor prior to enrolling into a course that is below 100 level as it will be at the student's expense and not available for community college credit. It is important that you check with colleges and universities you are interested in to see if they might take your transfer of community college "dual credit" as college credit.
