1. Parking permits are required for all students parking at the school and student parking is only allowed in the upper lot. The parking permit is issued to the student and the vehicle described on the front side of this card. You must notify the ASB Office when changing vehicles. Permits cannot be transferred to other students, and if you use a lost, stolen, altered or counterfeit permit, you will face disciplinary action by the School Administration.
2. Squalicum High School assumes no responsibility for damages or theft that may occur to vehicles parked in the school parking lot. **Please do not leave valuables in your vehicle.**
3. **The parking permit must be placed in the rear window-driver's side in such a manner as to be clearly visible from the outside of the vehicle.**
4. Students are allowed to park in the upper parking lot with a permit free of charge. **However, parking in the Visitor, Handicapped or the lower Staff Parking lot will result in disciplinary action and your parking privileges may be suspended.**
5. Each time you leave and enter the parking lot, it shall be done in a safe and cautious manner. The speed limit on campus is 10 miles per hour. Students are expected to yield when merging and using the appropriate entrance and exit lanes.
6. You can only return to your car to store or retrieve items. You cannot remain in your car during lunch or for any extended period of time.
7. During school hours, our campus is closed to all students except those with **junior/senior** off campus lunch privileges. You're not allowed to leave or take younger students off campus without authorization from the School Administration.
8. All violations will result with conversations with administration and campus security. If violations continue, it may result in disciplinary action and/or result in parking privileges being suspended.
9. Student drivers should report all fender benders and reckless driving to the main office as soon as possible.
